

TABLE RUNNER

MATERIALS:

1/4 yard Agave
1/4 yard Blender Parchment
1/3 yard Blender Turquoise
1/3 yard Chilis
1/2 yard Sand AZ
1/3 yard SW Diamonds
1 yard of fabric of choice for backing
Template for Dresden Plate at end of pattern

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Easy Dresden Ruler

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING THIS PROJECT. FABRICS ARE SEWN RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER USING A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS ARE BASED ON 40" WOF. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC; LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC; RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Agave Fabric:

Cut [2] — 3-1/2" × WOF strips **(A)**

From Blender Parchment Fabric:

Cut [2] — 3-1/2" × WOF strips **(B)**

From Blender Turquoise Fabric:

Cut [3] — circles using the circle template **(C)**

Cut [3] — 10" squares **(D)**

From Chilis Fabric:

Cut [2] — 10" squares **(E)**

From Sand AZ Fabric:

Cut [1] — 1-1/2" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] — 1-1/2" × 10" strips **(F)**

Cut [3] — 1-1/2" × WOF strips, Inner Border **(G,H)**

Cut [4] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Binding

From SW Diamonds Fabric:

Cut [4] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Outer Border **(I,J)**

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. SKIP this step if using Easy Dresden Ruler. Make a template of the Dresden blade from template plastic.
2. Using the template, cut [30] Dresden blades from the Agave 3-1/2" × WOF strips **(A)**.
3. Using the template, cut [30] Dresden blades from the Blender Parchment 3-1/2" × WOF strips **(B)**.
4. With RST, sew [3] Agave **(A)** blades to [2] Parchment **(B)** blades **(A-B-A-B-A)**. Repeat to make [6] quarter units.



5. With RST, sew [3] Parchment **(B)** blades to [2] Agave **(A)** blades **(B-A-B-A-B)**. Repeat to make [6] quarter units.



6. Sew [1] **(A-B-A-B-A)** unit to [1] **(B-A-B-A-B)** unit to form half a Dresden. Repeat to make [6] half-circle units.



7. Sew RST [2] half-circle units to make a full circle. Repeat to make [3] wheels.
8. Fold under outside of wheel 1/2" along the raw edge.



9. Center wheel on **(D)** and pin in place. Stitch around outside edge of wheel with a blanket, zigzag, or straight stitch.



10. Make a template of the circle from template plastic.
11. Using the template, cut [3] circles from Blender Turquoise.
12. Fold under outside of (C) 1/4" along the raw edge.
13. Center (C) in the middle of the wheel. Stitch around outside edge of (C) with a blanket, zigzag, or straight stitch. Make [3] wheel blocks.



ROW ASSEMBLY:

1. With RST, sew wheel, (F) strip, (E) square, wheel, (F) strip, (E) square, wheel to create center of table runner as shown.



BORDERS:

Inside Border

Using AZ Sand fabric, sew [3] strips together and subcut:

- [2] Long Borders: 1-1/2" x 52" (G)
- [2] Short Borders: 1-1/2" x 12" (H)

Outside Border

Using SW Diamonds fabric, sew [4] strips together and subcut:

- [2] Long Borders: 2-1/2" x 54" (I)
- [2] Short Borders: 2-1/2" x 16" (J)

1. Sew WOF strips RST along short edges. Cut to length specified above.



2. Sew (G) to each long edge of the table runner.
3. Sew (H) to each short edge of the table runner.



4. Sew (I) to each long edge of the table runner.



5. Sew (J) to each short edge of the table runner.



FINISHING:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Baste and Quilt.
3. Bind with the AZ Sand binding strips.
4. Enjoy!
